Crisis Intervention	SUD Crisis Intervention	SUH2011 SUH2011PSD	Face to face or telephone contact that focuses on alleviating crisis problems such as threat to safety (suicidal and or homicidal ideations). Crisis is also defined as an actual relapse or an unforeseen event or circumstance that presents to the client an imminent threat of relapse. Crisis intervention services shall be limited to stabilization of the emergency.	Alcohol and/or drug services; crisis intervention (outpatient)
